Rao Jodha Desert Rock Park राव जोधा डेजर्ट रॉक पार्क

Once a barren stretch below Mehrangarh, today it's a thriving ode to desert ecology. A model of restorative landscaping, the park revives 70 hectares of volcanic rock with native flora like dhonk and rohida—restoring what the desert always knew to grow.

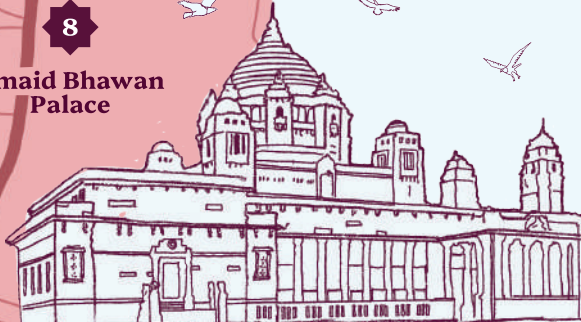
Sardar Government Museum सरदार सरकारी संग्रहालय

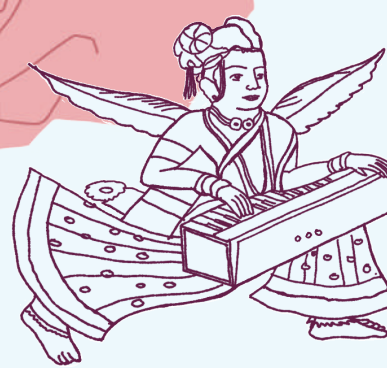

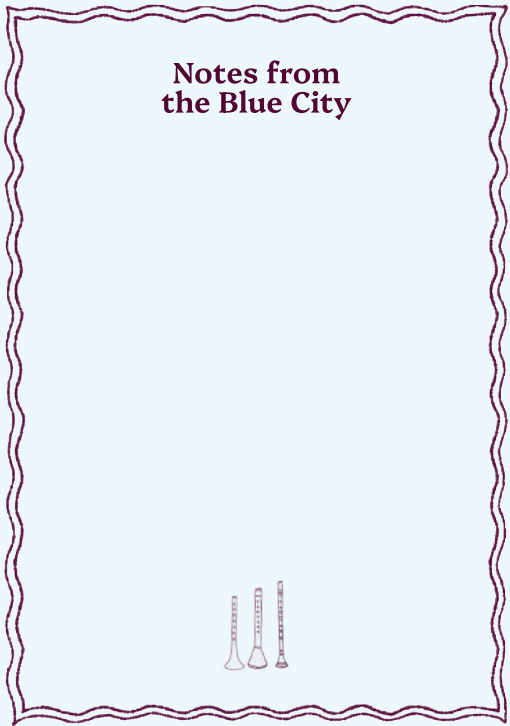
Ghanshyamji Temple घनश्यामजी का मंदिर

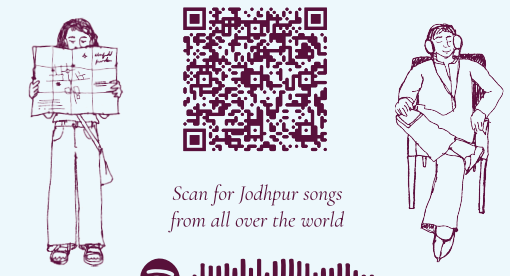

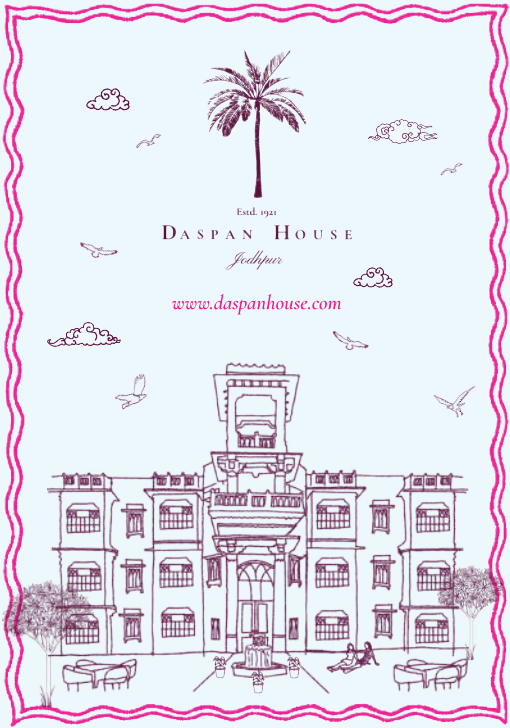

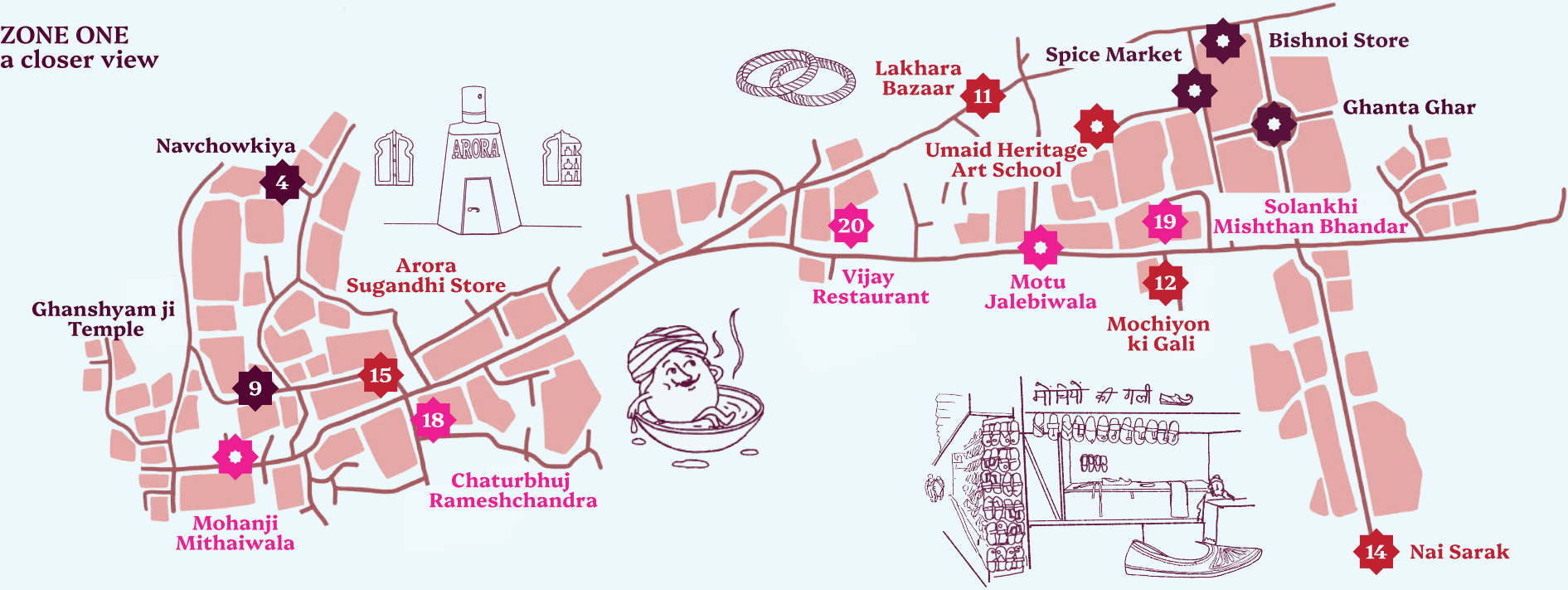


About Unfolding Jodhpur

HANDICRAFTS

Lalji is an antique store where every surface in their maze of rooms—walls, floors, and even ceilings—are brimming with curios. You walk in for a 'quick browse.' Only to find yourself debating whether you can pass off a four-foot brass camel as carry-on luggage.

Lakhara Bazaar

Where bangles are still made the old-fashioned way—by people, not machines. Generations of artisans twist, mold, and perfect lac with enviable precision. Whether you're here to admire the craft or just to shop, one thing's certain: you'll leave with more bangles than you planned.

Shiv Rabri Kulfi

Opposites attract at Shiv Rabdi—where the bold, fiery crunch of Nargisi Kofta meets the delicate sweetness of rabdi kulfi. It's Jodhpur's quirkiest duo, and one you don't want to miss.

Choudhary Namkeen

Some places boast an extensive menu. Choudhary Namkeen boasts one thing done exceptionally well—Mirchi Bada, a crispy, fiery rite of passage for anyone setting foot in Jodhpur. If the heat gets too much, you can seek relief in the delicious imarti, fresh out of the frying pan, or cool down with a glass of chaach.

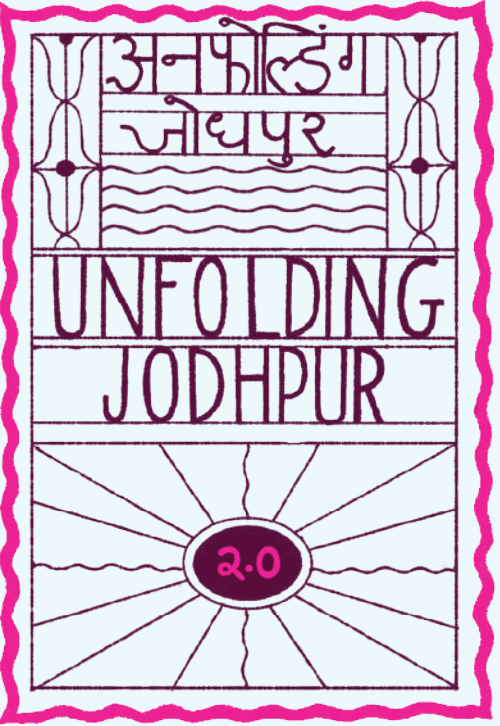
